Our 2023 junior competition grew tremendously with 42 junior teams with a growth of 10 teams from the previous season and a total of 343 players aged 12 and under registered.

Our senior competition comprised of a total of 67 teams across the mixed, men's and women's competitions.

We had 4 senior representative teams and 11 junior representative teams selected for the 23/24 season.

This year would have to be our most successful junior representative season with our U12 girls winning 5 tournaments and only dropping one game throughout all tournaments. They were crowned Don Green Champions, West South West Suns Champions, Peter Wilson Champions, Junior State Cup Champions and finally State Champions. A massive achievement for our club and congratulations to all of the girls and coaching staff.

We also sent our first ever girls youth league team to Vawden Cup in Sydney. These girls were very competitive bowing out in the semi-finals in a 3 on 3 drop off. A great experience and great growth for our players and our club.

We had numerous players represent us through further representative teams at Junior Regionals and Nationals, a great achievement for these players and our club.

We were successful in hosting numerous tournaments throughout the season including Country Championships, Don Green and Junior Regionals. The feedback we received was extremely positive and a credit to our Council and all members of our touch community. Hosting these tournaments was a lot of hard work and a huge thank you to everyone who lended a hand and also to Simone for once again providing amazing options in our canteen.

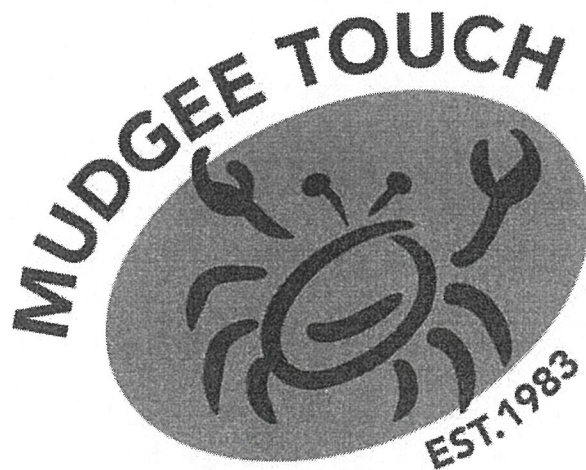

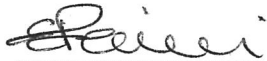

My goal is to provide the committee with greater visibility over the club's income and expenditure, allowing us to make more informed financial decisions and ensure the club's funds are being managed as effectively as possible.

This will include more detailed tracking of event expenses, equipment purchases, representative costs and other operational spending so we have a clearer picture of where the money is being allocated. This will also assist with budgeting, future planning and identifying opportunities to reduce expenditure while continuing to invest in our members. We are fortunate to have an impressive number of representatives across our junior, senior and refereeing pathways, and I would love to see the club, where financially able, provide greater support to those representing our club at regional, state and national levels.

Financial Snapshot
